Notes

Whether the Thornborough context is pre- or post-43 in absolute terms, these contexts are both essentially native. The Thornborough pot is thin, elaborate, and red-surfaced, and the Berkhamsted pot is in 'light brown ware'; they may both be derived from continental originals (cf. Holwerda 1941, pi. XII, no.606 - 'terra nigra').
