

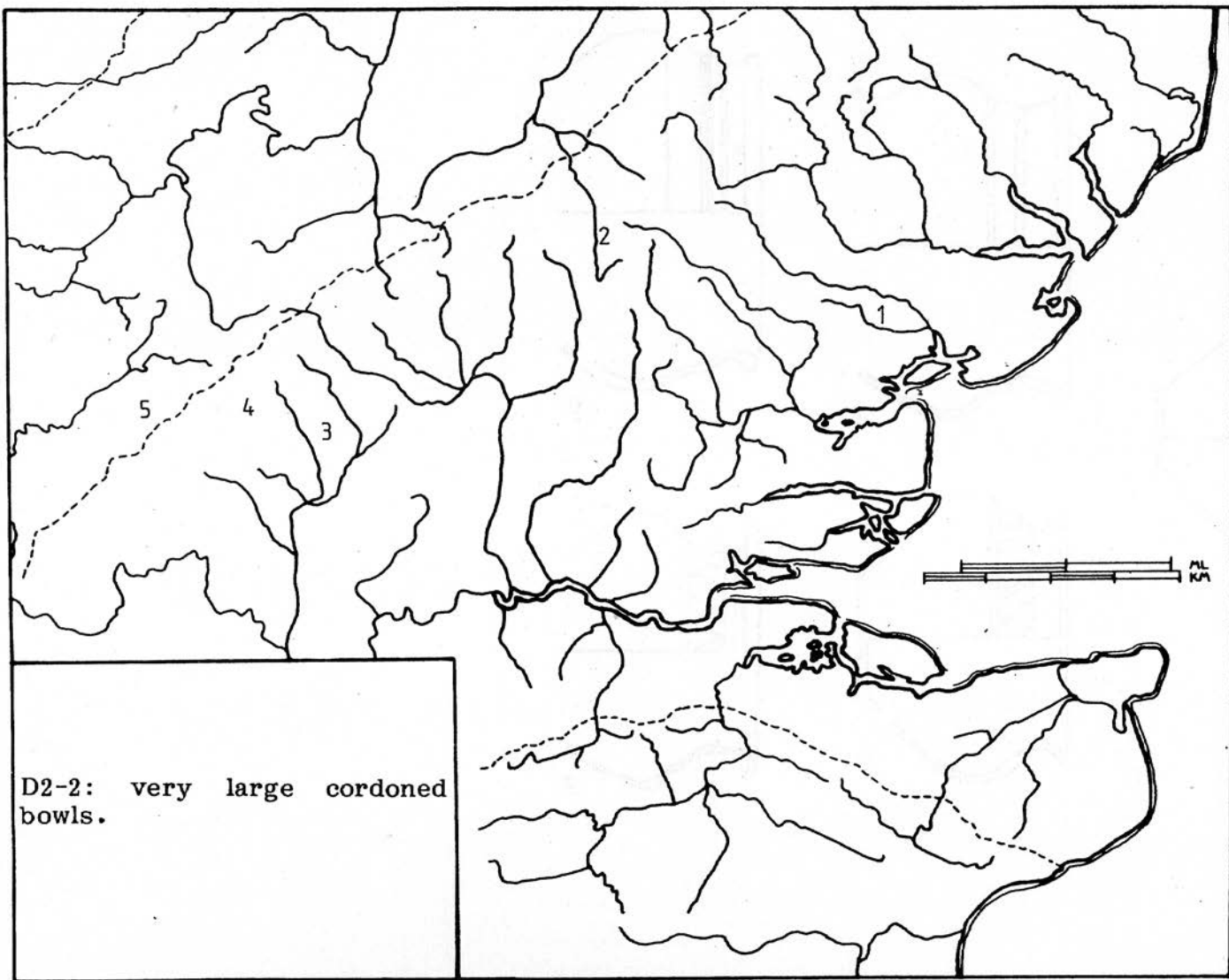
D2-2: VERY LARGE CORDONED BOWLS

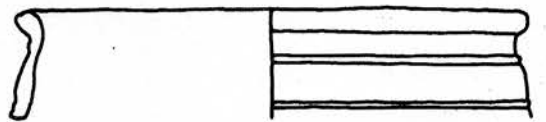
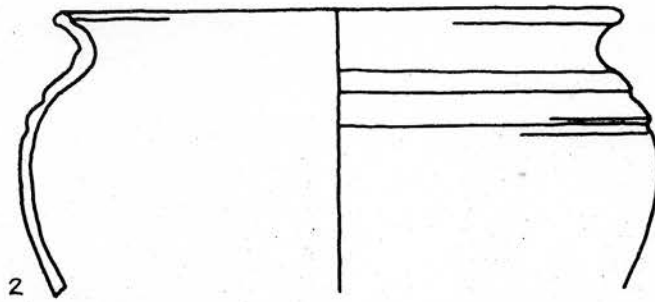
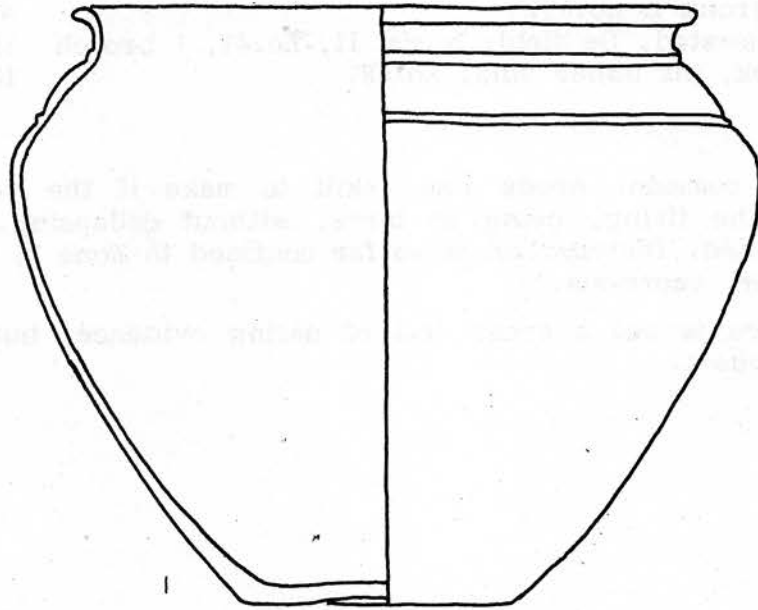

Notes

Not common; needs some skill to make if the vessel is to survive the firing, being so large, without collapsing. They are well finished. Distribution is so far confined to Zone 7, and one at Colchester, enormous.

There is not a great deal of dating evidence, but none are post-conquest.
