Notes

An occasional variant close to major production centres. The Sheepen pot was described as grey-brown, 'almost TR4'; I have not seen it, and the other 'unique forms related to Cam.218' are Roman in fabric. The group A vessel from Prae Wood is also anomalous, being buff with grey core and no discernible temper. It is not an early form.
