Notes

These are, I am sure, examples of the potter testing his skill; each is an extension of the E1-1 form, yet are found apparently independently, at opposite ends of the area of grog-tempering. The Canewdon vessel is not as thin and sharply modelled as the Odell example, which has a romanised air; Odell seems to have had an experimental potter in the vicinity, as the site has produced several extreme forms, as yet unpublished.
