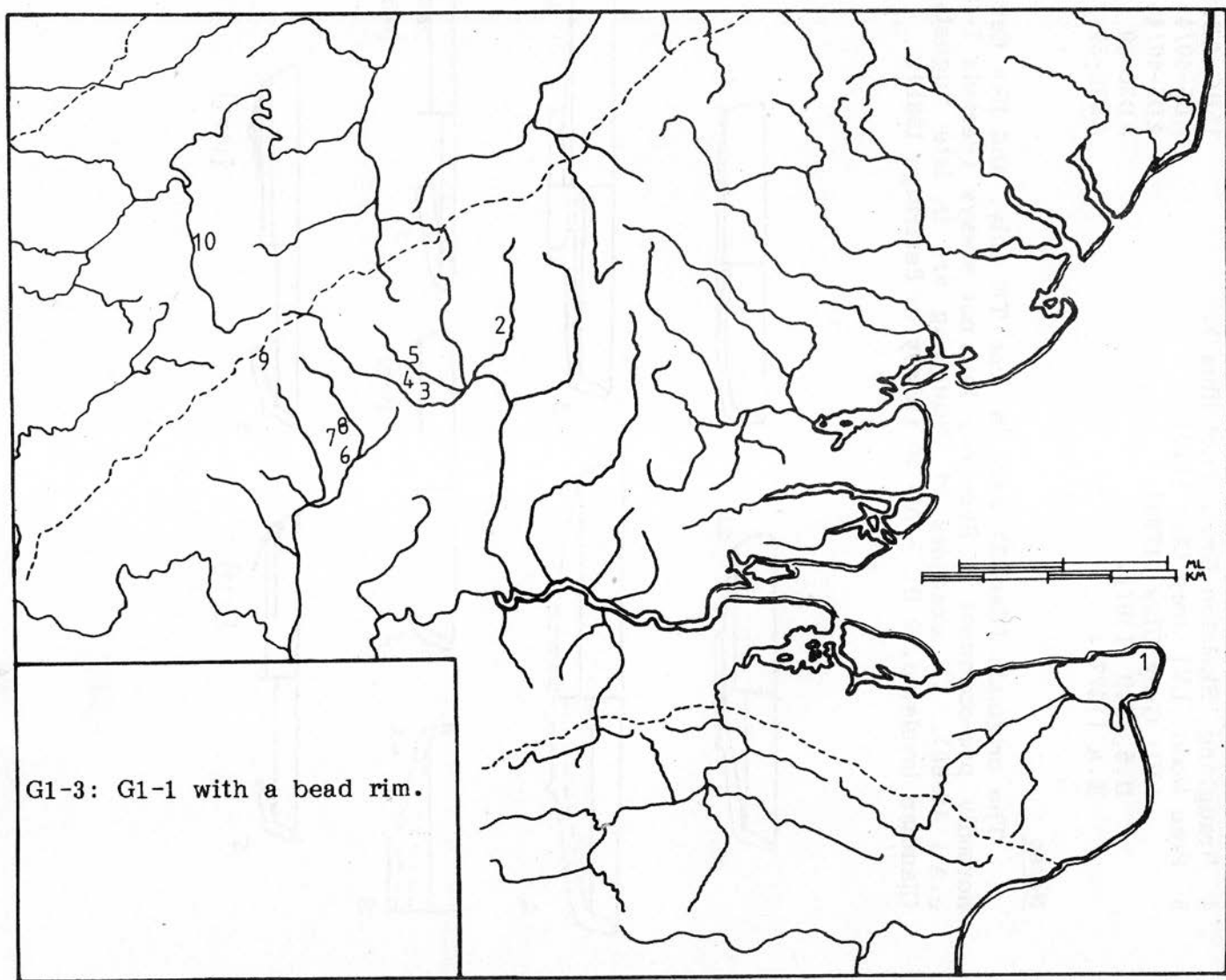


PLATE 1 WITH A BROAD RIM
