

D1-5: PLAIN NECKED BOWLS WITHOUT TRUE DEFINED OFFSET
OR CORDON

Sometimes with rough decoration, an early feature at Braughing sites. The form at Braughing first occurs at Gatesbury Track in a feature beginning c.20 BC, and is fairly common in the Braughing complex, but hardly occurs elsewhere: they seem to be the product of local potters for local markets.
