## Notes

This superb form is confined, it seems, to Kent, and to rich burials of the 1st century BC. The Kelvedon rim [1490], unstratified, is possibly another; other forms show coastal links between Kent and Zone 1.

Two parallels are known from adjoining areas of France: Bellozanne, Seine Inferieure (Hawkes and Dunning 1930, fig. 15 no.43); Wissant, Pas-de-Calais (Mariette 1966, fig. 18 no.83).

It does not appear to occur elsewhere in France.
