Notes

It is unfortunate that so many of these are unstratified, but Braughing and Prae Wood provide a long date range, from the last quarter of the 1st century BC to the conquest period. As a form it is half way between the wide-mouthed E3-1 and the true flask shape, E3-6, and there is some overlap; it is found everywhere in the main area of grog-tempering but some examples are in local fabrics. The Birchington pot is grog-tempered but Roman in form; the Epple Bay cemetery is later 1st century AD.
