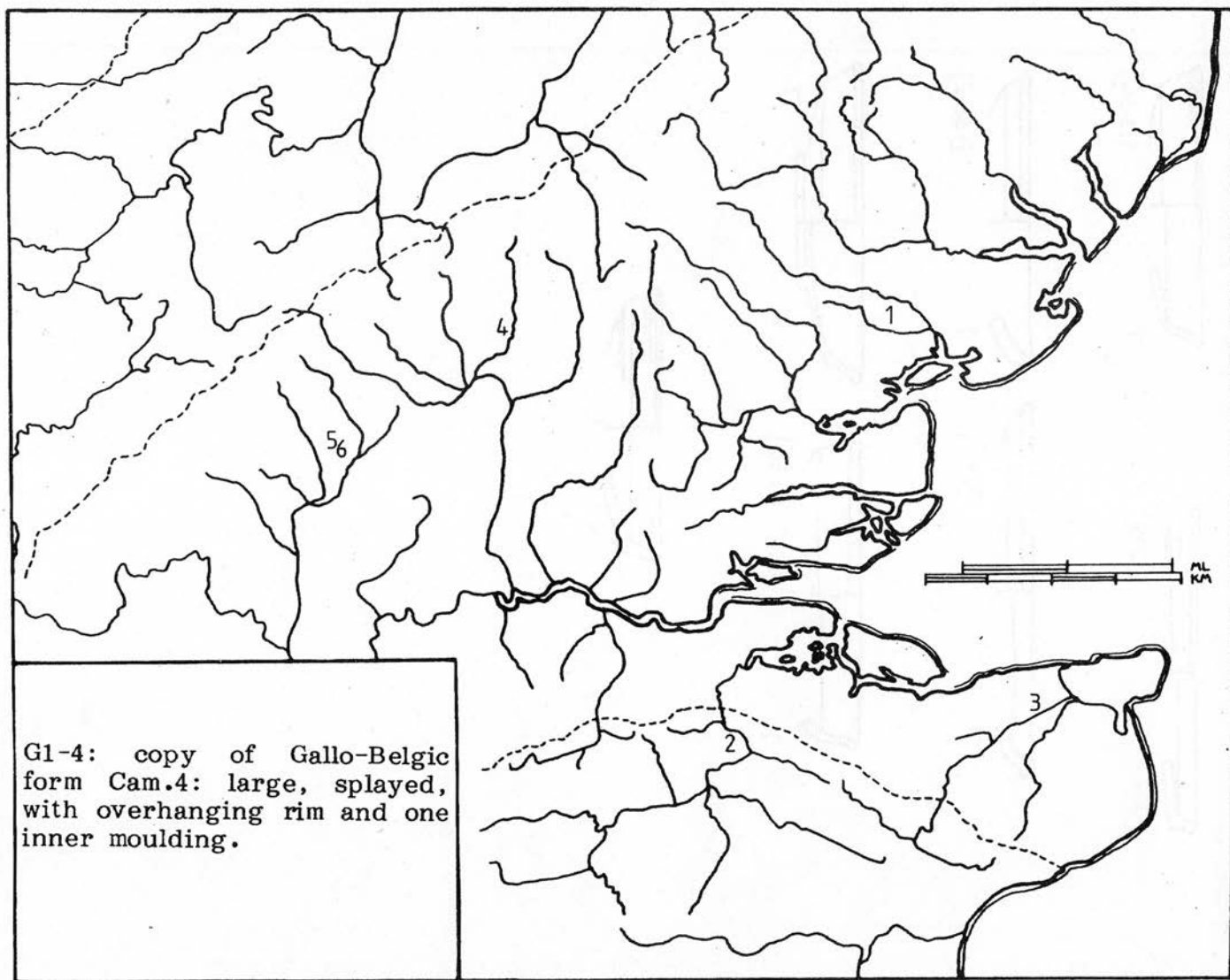
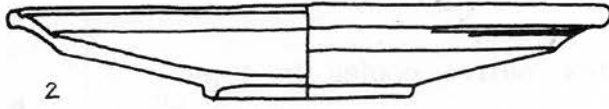


G1-4: COPY OF GALLO-BELGIC FORM Cam.4: LARGE, SPLAYED,
WITH OVERHANGING RIM AND ONE INNER MOULDING

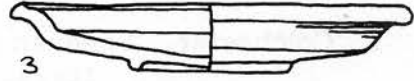
Very common at Prae Wood but rare elsewhere. The original is usually in TN, but not always; from c.10 BC at Braughing, and at Claudian Hofheim.
