## Notes

Hawkes and Hull compared Cam.251 with the very common continental late La Tene form; the fabric of these Sheepen specimens is an odd pitted grey and there is nothing quite like them in Britain. No base was found.

The others are rather different, with out-curved rim, and appear related to the following bowl forms with exaggerated rim flanges. The Prae Wood pot is the one specimen that might be related to the Sheepen vessels.
