This includes those for which brief notices have appeared, whose pottery I have not seen; and contemporary discoveries without coarse pottery.

Ditches, 3 cremations, and '1st century AD' pottery (Cockett 1976).
- BISHOPS STORTFORD (H) TL 488 200 Zone 7  
Early Roman in Stane St ditch but no 'Belgic' so far (Ellcock 1970; Britannia 1, 1970, 311).
- BURTONS GREEN (E) TL 826 271  
Pottery, not pre-conquest (Lindsay 1958, 243, 'Burton Green'; VCH 1963, 137).
- CAVENDISH (S) TL 795 454  
Pot from river Stour, 1952 (Elliot 1955).
- CHIGNALL ST JAMES (E) TL 662 107 Zone 1  
Pre-villa features: pits, trackway, field system (C. Couchman 1977a, 77-84; Britannia 11, 1980, 376).
- DARENTH (K) TQ 554 676 Zone 3  
Iron Age settlement excavated 1975-76; pottery (Philp 1976a, 161).
- DEDHAM (E) TM 068 325 Zone 1  
Earthwork, pottery (VCH 1963, 124).
- DOVER (K) TR 326 418 Zone 6  
Late Iron Age pottery on the Castle hill; possible hill fort (Bayly 1962, xlvi; Champion 1976, 118; Colvin 1959).
- DUNSTABLE (B) TL 019 217 Zone 7  
Butt-beaker in mouth of filled-in Roman well (Matthews & Hutchings 1972).
- EAST MALLING (K) TQ 703 570 Zone 4  
'Belgic pottery' in early levels on Roman site (A. Wachter 1965).
- ECCLES (K) TQ 722 605 (villa)  
TQ 718 605 (kilns) Zone 4  
Kilns AD 45-65, early Roman fine wares; not related to native tradition (summary, Detsicas 1976, 162; pots, Detsicas 1977; Claudian ditch on villa site, Detsicas 1965, xlvi).

- FARNINGHAM (K) TQ 543 674 Zone 3  
Late Iron Age farmstead (Philp 1975, 122).
- FORDWICH (K) TR 195 594 Zone 5  
Hut and ditch with sherds of AD 10-43 (Jenkins 1962, 12).
- GESTINGTHORPE (E) TL 82 38  
Roman site at Hill Farm with some early pottery (VCH 1963, 133; D.F. Allen 1971, 145, potin coin; Lindsay 1958, 27, & combed sherds, 67).
- GOSFIELD (E) TL 777 294  
Storage jars, and Roman pots. Probably not pre-conquest (Lindsay 1958, 243; 207-8).
- GREATSTONE (K) c.TR 08 23 Zone 6  
Pottery in Soil Survey pits (Champion 1976; Green & Askew 1959, 35).
- GREAT WALDINGFIELD (S) TM 28 44  
Belgic cinerary pots reported (R.R. Clarke 1939, 110; Owles & Smedley 1970, 103).
- HADLEY WOOD CAMP (H) TQ 263 972 Zone 7  
Earthwork, no finds (Renn 1952-54, 204-6, no date; cf. W. Rodwell 1976a, 330).
- HALSTEAD (E) TL 820 295  
Early pottery on villa site, but listed forms could all be post-conquest (Lindsay 1958, 96, 261; Smallwood 1962).
- HASTINGLEIGH (K) TR 1070 4414 Zone 5  
Sherds from ?pit, Kingsmill Down Farm (Bradshaw 1973, 217).
- HATFIELD (H) c.TL 21 09 Zone 7  
Sherds from aerodrome (W.R. Hughes 1938, 149).
- HIGH EASTER (E) TL 6220 1485  
Base sherd with grog and shell, 'late Belgic' (W. Rodwell 1976c, 242).
- HIGH ROCKS (K) TQ 562 383  
Sherds of 'Belgic ware' from hill fort, but not stratified (Money 1958, lxvi; 1959, liv; Champion 1976, 129).
- HOLLINGBOURNE (K) c.TQ 82 55 Zone 4/5  
Pottery in ditch (Pirie 1958a, 222); potin coin from TQ 846 555 (Kelly 1977, 208).

- ICKLEFORD (H) c.TL 18 31 Zone 7  
 'Tazza' in 'St Albans County Museum' cannot be traced (Westell and Applebaum 1933, 253).
- INGRAVE (E) TQ 6223 9300  
 'Belgic' sherd, probably post-43, with later material at St Nicholas Old Church (C. Couchman 1977c).
- KEDINGTON (S) c.TL 70 46  
 Amphora (Fell, Lethbridge and Bushnell 1949, 129; W. Rodwell 1976a, 323).
- LINSELL (E) c.TL 64 27  
 Amphora (Stead 1967, 60; Peacock 1971, 184; W. Rodwell 1976a, 320). Glass bead (Going 1977, 16-18).
- LITTLE CHART (K) TQ 939 458 Zone 5  
 Pottery in pit near bath house; post-conquest (Eames 1957, 144).
- LITTLE HADHAM (H) c.TL 440 227 Zone 7  
 Amphorae (Stead 1967, 60).
- LORD'S BRIDGE (C) TL 395 545 Zone 9  
 Firedog and chain; tumulus; amphora grave - without known interconnections (Walker 1908; Piggott 1971, 249; E.D. Clarke 1821, 61).
- MAIDEN BOWER (B) SP 996 225 Zone 7  
 Sherds on hill fort site (Matthews 1976, 165).
- MARDLEYBURY (H) TL 253 175 Zone 7  
 Dressel I amphora, probable burial. Close to Datchworth (Stead 1967, 60).
- MARKS TEY (E) TL 23 91 Zone 1  
 Possible amphora grave, destroyed (W. Rodwell 1976a, 319; 1976d).
- MAULDEN FIRS (B) TL 094 275 Zone 7  
 Iron Age and 'Belgic' sherds (Dyer 1964).
- MAULDEN MOOR (B) c.TL 060 380  
 Amphora grave, lost (Stead 1967, 60; Peacock 1971, 182).

- MOUNT BURES (S) TL 907 322 Zone 1  
 'Chieftain' grave including many platters; all now lost except  
 firedog (C.R. Smith 1852; Stead 1967, 53; Peacock 1971, 184; W.  
 Rodwell 1976a, 319).
- OARE (K) TR 0080 6336 Zone 5  
 Pottery in ditch (Gidlow 1969, 238); TN cup in RM (Jenkins  
 1962, fig.2 no.12).
- OLD WARDEN (B) TL 135 446 (i) Zone 7  
 (i) Old Warden A: amphorae, shale, metal (Birchall 1965, 255;  
 Fox 1923, 98, pl.XV, 3; Stead 1971).  
 (ii) Old Warden B: mirror, coins, amphorae, bronze (R.A.  
 Smith 1909, 333-4; Fox 1958, pl.60).  
 (iii) another mirror (Dyer 1966).
- ORPINGTON (K) Zone 3  
 (i) TQ 471 674, ?'Belgic' burial sherds, Reynolds Cross  
 (Parsons 1957, 240).  
 (ii) TQ 4540 6583, hut and pottery on villa site (Parsons  
 1958, 210).
- PEBMARSH (E) c.TL 841 326  
 Not 'Belgic' pottery, despite Smallwood (1961-65, fig.5 no.16;  
 cf. VCH 1963, 166).
- RAINHAM (E) TQ 550 843 Zone 2  
 Possible pottery, Besecarr gravel pit (O'Leary 1962); triple-  
 ditched enclosure with pottery, Moor Hall Farm, 545 820 (Britannia  
 9, 1978, 452).
- RAMSDEN (K) TQ 474 661 Zone 3  
 Farmstead, with pottery (Blumstein 1957; Champion 1976,  
 142-3).
- RAWRETH (E) TQ 774 929 Zone 2  
 Sherds in field scatter (on late Roman site) (Drury 1977, 34).
- RIVENHALL (E) TL 828 178 Zone 1  
 Pre-villa occupation and burials (Brinson 1950-51b; W.  
 Rodwell 1973; VCH 1963, 171); a second mirror (W. Rodwell 1978,  
 15); amphora in cemetery (W. Rodwell 1976a, 322); map (Rodwell  
 and Rodwell 1973; W. Rodwell 1972b); rectilinear buildings (K.  
 Rodwell 1979, 330).
- RUSHDEN (N) SP 943 660 Zone 8  
 Kilns, and unusual pottery (Selkirk 1972; Woods 1974).

- ST MARY IN THE MARSH (K) TR 081 276 Zone 6  
Pottery (Smart, Bisson and Worssam 1966, 260; reference from Champion 1976, 298).
- SHABBINGTON (Bu) SP 6733 0764 Zone 7  
'Belgic' features recorded (Farley 1977, 482).
- STANFORDBURY (B) c.TL 148 412 Zone 7  
Two 'chieftain' graves, Claudian; confused (Stead 1967, 47, 55-56; Peacock 1971, 182; Kennett 1971b).
- STANMORE PARK (Mx) c.TL 17 93 Zone 7  
Amphora (Peacock 1971, 185; W. Rodwell 1976a, 324).
- STEBBING (E) TL 64 26  
Early post-conquest cemetery (Going n.d.; Going 1978, 12-13; 1980; Britannia 9 (1978), 452).
- STEVENAGE (H) TL 2440 2477  
Two Roman burials, not Belgic (Holmes 1952-54b).
- STOKE-BY-CLARE (S) c.TL 74 43  
'Belgic pottery' according to Lindsay (1958, 198-9), but unreliable.
- STRATFORD ST MARY (S) c.TM 04 34 Zone 1  
Amphora (CMR 1933, 11; Peacock 1971, 184).
- THAXTED (E) c.TL 61 31  
Amphora (W. Rodwell 1976d). See also WHITE COLNE.
- TOLLESBURY (E)  
Red Hill with a few small sherds (De Brisay 1978, 6; Britannia 9, 1978, 452).
- WAVENDON HEATH (Bu) c.SP 92 34 Zone 7/8  
Amphora burial (Peacock 1971, 182; W. Rodwell 1976a, 324).
- WESTHALL (S)  
Shale vessel, TM 4092 8161 (Rudolf 1964); bronze hoard, TM 397 806 (E.A. Martin 1978).
- WESTMILL (H) c.TL 370 270 Zone 7  
Amphorae (Stead 1967; 60). The Ordnance Survey Iron Age map puts them at TL 380 271.
